



BRASILIAN SCENARIO



NARCOGARIMPO - PCC ACTS AS "TRUSTEE" IN YANOMAMI LAND

At the beginning of the year, midanuary 2023, the episode was publicized in light of a public health crisis in the Yanomami indigenous land, where around 20,000 illegal prospectors invaded, shedding light on the illegal gold trade that fuels mining.

Such a federal law for the purchase and sale of gold, approved by then-president Dilma Rousseff (PT) on July 19, 2013, may open loopholes to facilitate illegal mining. Paragraph 4 of article 39 of Law 12,844/2013 provides for "presumed legality" for gold sellers and "good faith" for buyers of the metal.

The current law allows licensed securities dealers (DTVM) to buy gold mined in Brazil without specifying the origin of the ore. As a result, miners must record, often on handwritten paper, the origin of the material - whether the information is true or not. In other words, the current mining law allows miners to turn illegal gold into legal gold.

"This law, unfortunately, allows illegal gold, as if by magic, to be transformed into legal gold.

PCC ACTION STRENGTHENS PROSPECTORS PERMANENCE IN THE YANOMAMI AREA



The First Command of the Capital, the PCC, and other criminal factions have encouraged prospectors to stay on Yanomami lands in Roraima. The apprehension has grown since last Saturday (29)April, when gold miner murdered an indigenous leader. Totaling thirteen this week alone.

Investigation: mining in the Yanomami area is supported by organized crime

One of the four miners killed by security agents last Sunday (30)April in the Yanomami Indigenous Land, in Roraima, was a member of a criminal faction with nationwide operations. This line of investigation became one of the focuses of the federal government's intelligence actions in the region. The information was revealed by the president of the Brazilian Institute for the Environment and Renewable Natural Resources (Ibama), Rodrigo Agostinho, in an interview with journalists in Boa Vista, on Monday night (1st-may)

A day later, four prospectors allegedly reacted to the incursion by agents of the Federal Highway Police (PRF) and IBAMA at a mining site known as Ouro Mil, inside the indigenous land. They ended up being killed in a confrontation. Agência Brasil found that one of the dead with ties to organized crime is from Amapá. He is appointed as a member of the PCC group, which originated in São Paulo but operates throughout the country. At the scene of the confrontation, according to the PRF, an arsenal of weapons was seized, with a rifle, three pistols, seven shotguns, and two holographic sights, in addition to ammunition of various calibers, chargers, and other military equipment.

Washing and capitalization

According to the president of Ibama, (Brazilian Institute for the Environment and Renewable Natural Resources) the activities of criminal factions are increasingly common in illegal extractive activities, such as minings, land grabbing, and the clandestine trade in wood. We have noticed that these activities have attracted criminal factions. They serve, at the same time, as a form of money laundering, through illegal mining, for example, but also as a source of capitalization for these groups, since international drug trafficking demands a large investment in operation, explained Rodrigo Agostinho, in conversation

with Agência Brasil.

Balance

Ibama informed that, since the beginning of the operation, about three months ago, 327 camps of garimpeiros, 18 planes, two helicopters, hundreds of engines, and dozens of rafts, boats, and tractors were destroyed.

PL2630 FAKE NEWS LAW OR CENSORSHIP (PROJECT OF LAW)

Now in May, a Proposal for a Law -PL 2630, also known as the Fake News Law, was presented in the **Federal** Senate bv Senator Alessandro Vieira (CIDADANIA - SE) which defined it as the Brazilian Law of Freedom, Responsibility Transparency on the Internet, SO THAT NO. This proposed law is nothing more than an attempt by the current government to SHUT since citizens the Internet has become

the largest current means of communication since the current media are all LEFT TENNENT.

Thus, through applications such as Twitter, we BRAZILIAN CITIZENS can access and disclose everything that HAPPENS IN THE COUNTRY with just one click. Thus, the only way to SILENCE society is to prevent us CITIZENS from disclosing information and preventing our participation in political debates that we carry out through the Internet and applications.

MAIN ASPECTS OF THE PROPOSAL

From the presentation of the initial text to the vote in the Senate, the Bill received no less than 152 amendments at the discretion of the left in collusion with the institutions that support them.

1º - establishes norms, guidelines, and transparency mechanisms for providers of social networks and private messaging services order to guarantee security, broad of freedom expression, communication, and expression of thought, which is not true, this text in the form in which it was approved is actually a SHUT UP of the Brazilian population. funniest thing is that the Law excludes providers of networks and private messaging services with less than two million registered Brazilian users from complying with its determinations, that is, if the big tech that has few USERS who can be influenced by its content, these do not represent any type of risk, and are outside the determinations of the legal text.

The proposal talks about a program of good practices seeking application based on "adequate and proportionate measures to combat inauthentic behavior and transparency regarding paid content" in its art. 3rd:

- a) freedom of expression and the press;
- b) the guarantee of the rights of personality, dignity, honor, and privacy;
- c) respect for the formation of political preferences and a personal worldview of the user;
- d) sharing the responsibility for preserving a free, plural, diverse, and democratic public sphere;
- e) guaranteeing the reliability and integrity of information systems;
- f) promoting access to knowledge of matters of public interest;
- g) consumer protection; It is
- h) transparency in the rules for advertisements and sponsored content.

RESPONSIBILITY MEASURES

In addition to defining what you can or cannot see on the Internet, the text of the law proposes yet another measure to be taken which is the restriction, through use policies, of the number of accounts per user (art. 6, § 5), or that is, the law will also limit the number of accounts that you can have in each application, in addition to allowing the user identification requirements using a valid identity document.



LIMITATIONS PROPOSED BY LAW

Private messaging services such as WhatsApp must allow users to accept or reject their inclusion in message groups and transmission lists, in addition to disabling, by default, the inclusion of users in forwarding messages to multiple recipients (art. 9th, III, IV).

For legal purposes, social networks must keep records of massive messages sent to more than a thousand users and whose content has been identified as illicit, this is the case of the feared and infamous ROBOTS that represent an attack on the DEMOCRATIC STATE OF RIGHT, according to the PEOPLE OF THE **CURRENT GOVERNMENT.** To completely take away your freedom of expression and place us under the supervision of a VERIFICATION **BODY COMPOSED** LEFTISTS WITHOUT ANY COMMITMENT TO THE TRUTH, the final version of the PL, social networks are now responsible for publishing, quarterly, transparency reports containing a series of information related the to practices program proposed by the Law.

To this end, the article proposes combating the spread of misinformation and artificial content distribution networks, since it INTIMIDATES, and DISCOURAGES users from sharing content that is considered inauthentic by LEFTIST VERIFIERS.

RESPONSIBILITY of the public authorities - TRANSPARENCY Council

This is a ready-made joke, the bill establishes a series of responsibilities related to the Brazilian Public Administration. Even what deputies, senators, governors, councilors, and mayors publish are subject to the appreciation of such councils. However, art. 24 of the PL protects:

Art. 24. It is forbidden to persecute and in any way harm the public servant due to content shared by

him privately, outside the exercise of his functions and that does not constitute material whose publication is prohibited by law. That is, the text also creates an Internet Transparency and Responsibility Council, which of 21 should be composed advisers, with individuals from different sectors of Administration and civil society, CERTAINLY SENT BY IDEOLOGICAL LEFT, WHICH WILL SAY IF ITS CONTENT IT IS OR NOT CONSIDERED AN ATTACK **DEMOCRACY.**

As for the sanctions applied by the project, we see the main ones:

Chapter VI of PL 2.630/2020 establishes the following sanctions: Art. 31. Without prejudice to other

civil, criminal, or administrative sanctions, providers of social networks and private messaging services are subject to:

I – Warning, indicating the deadline for adopting corrective measures; or

II – Fine of up to 10% (ten percent) of the revenue of the economic group in Brazil in the last financial year.

§1 In applying the sanction, the judicial authority will observe proportionality, considering the economic condition of the offender, the consequences of the infraction in the collective sphere, and

recidivism.

§ 2 For this Law, anyone who repeats previously sanctioned conduct within 6 (six) months will be considered a repeat offender.

Taking into account the facts of this week, in which the court condemned FACEBOOK to pay a fine of more than ONE MILLION REAIS, just for failing to present a document as requested, we see a CLEAR MESSAGE for the media that dare to say ANYTHING AGAINST THE FAMILY PL OF FAKE NEWS, THIS WAS A CLEAR MESSAGE TO BIG TECHS.

THE APPLICATION OF THESE SANCTIONS to those who dare to go against THE WILL OF THE ALL POWERFUL, it is already clear that the positioning of justice, AS WAS EXPECTED, is on the side of those who want to IMPOSE censorship AT ANY PRICE, since the non-presentation of a document entails the penalty of a millionaire fine, as if money grew on trees, and not with the sweat of work.

So, at the moment, we do not see high expectations regarding this issue of sanctions imposed by laws, since the JUDICIARY system as a whole is marked by scandals of corruption and LEFT VIEZ, as we see today.

SOME CONSIDERATIONS

We are aware of the difficulty in identifying uninformative content or lying content, most users do not check or verify the information before disclosing it and this represents a major problem since FALSE content is disseminated all the time on the Internet, both by the left, how much to the right. As we said above, opposing the proposals of PL 2630/2020, we highlight once again the lack of consensus on the subject, as there is currently no single vision in parliament or society that guarantees the EFFECTIVENESS of public authorities in applying the determinations or sanctions imposed by the Fake News Law.

The main point that draws our attention is the restriction of users, and the censorship proposed by law, putting at risk the freedom of expression that is guaranteed by the FEDERAL CONSTITUTION.

One of the unintended consequences, for example, is that the PL ends up protecting those who produce misinformation, resulting in the creation of more misinformation.

In practice, as a result of PL 2630, platforms would prevented from be removing journalistic content with false claims such as The Covid-19 vaccine will modify the of human DNA beings. that is, they would continue to be available in Google search, YouTube, generating even more misinformation.

MORAES SENDS PF TO LISTEN TO DIRECTORS OF BIG TECHS (GOOGLE, META, AND SPOTIFY)

After Google spoke out against PL 2630 through its search page, Spotify also ran the Google ad: "The fake news bill may increase confusion about what is true and what is a lie in Brazil, so, we need to improve the text of PL 2630. Talk to your deputies on social networks even today, and access the Google Brazil blog to learn more". In addition to Spotify, Brasil Paralelo and Grupo Meta also announced on Google against PL2630.

Given this, Minister Alexandre de Morais determined, this Tuesday afternoon (2/5), that the Federal Police hear the director of Google in Brazil about advertising against the fake news bill.

DECISION IN FULL



Such conduct can configure, in theory, not only abuse of economic power on the eve of voting on the bill by trying to ILLEGAL and IMMORAL impact public opinion and the vote of parliamentarians, but also flagrant inducement and instigation to the maintenance of various criminal conduct practiced by the digital militias investigated in INQ 4.874, with aggravation of risks to the security of the FEDERAL SUPREME COURT and of the Democratic Rule of Law itself, whose protection is the cause of the establishment of INQ. 4.781.

Companies, within 48 (forty- eight) hours, must send a detailed report on the advertisements made and amounts invested, as well as the terms suggested by the Google search engine related to the subject;

4) GOOGLE, META, SPOTIFY, and BRASIL PARALELO inform the real and concrete measures - sending protocols and documents that prove the allegations - that they take to PREVENT, MITIGATE and REMOVE illicit practices within the scope of their services and in the fight against misinformation of generated content by third parties, mainly those targeted by algorithms, driven and generating advertising whose distribution has been carried out by payment to the social network provider or by inauthentic accounts and artificial distribution networks. TELEGRAM SENDS A MESSAGE TO USERS NOTIFYING THEM ABOUT PL2630

Democracy is under attack in Brazil. The Chamber of Deputies is expected to vote soon on PL 2630/2020, which was recently amended to include more than 20 completely new articles that have never been widely debated. See how this bill will kill the modern internet if it passes with its current wording. If approved, companies like Telegram may have to stop providing services in Brazil.

Gives Government Censorship Powers This bill allows the government to limit what can be said online by forcing apps to proactively remove facts or opinions it deems "unacceptable"; [1] (https://telegra.ph/PL-2630-2020-BR#1) and suspend any internet service - without a court order. [2] (https://telegra.ph/PL-2630-2020-BR#2).

For example, the Minister of Justice recently requested sanctions against Telegram, claiming that the application "did not respond to a request" - even before the request was made (https://t.me/TelegramBR/157). If PL 2630/2020 had been in force, the government could have immediately blocked the app as a "preventive measure" until Telegram proved that it did not violate any law.

Shifts Judicial Powers To Apps This bill makes digital platforms responsible for deciding what content is "illegal" rather than the courts - and provides overly broad definitions of illegal content. [3] (https://telegra.ph/PL-2630-2020-BR#3).

To avoid fines, platforms will choose to remove any opinions related to controversial topics, especially topics that are not aligned with the views of any government currently in power, which directly puts democracy at risk.

Creates a Permanent Surveillance System. The bill requires platforms to monitor communications and inform law enforcement if a crime is suspected to have taken place or may take place in the future.

This creates a permanent surveillance system, similar to that of countries with anti-democratic regimes. It's unnecessary.

Brazil already has laws to deal with the criminal activities that this bill is intended to cover (including attacks on democracy).




In recent days, the STF – Federal Supreme Court determined that the CEOs of some of the Big Techs that operate in Brazil should be summoned to provide clarification on their position against PL 2630, let's understand what is happening.

The Laboratory of Internet and Social Media Studies (NetLab) at the Federal University of Rio de Janeiro carried out a study entitled THE WAR OF THE PLATFORMS AGAINST PL2630, nicknamed the PL of fake news. This study was published in April stating that there was evidence that the giant Google had been presenting biased search results on its page for users who search for subjects related to the bill PL 2630, privileging, and emphasizing content critical to the text.

According to NetLab researchers, if PL 2630 is not approved, the big techs, as digital platforms such as Google are called, manage to maintain the regulatory asymmetry that exists in the market. The survey also revealed that if PL 2630 is not approved, the competitive advantages of big techs will increase more and more compared to other means of communication that also live on advertising.

This is how the study reported: "It's just platforms these are already moderate content, but they do it on their own, without specifying what the criteria are. Because, when they recommend some content to any user, they are defining what will have visibility, and what will have reach. As they are doing editorial work, there is a demand for accountability, as well as the media. The issue of transparency is essential and the lack of rules for digital advertising is also posed as a central issue precisely because, somehow, they profit from ads that promote the purchase of weapons, coup d'état, financial fraud." In a note about this study presented, Google manifests itself saying, ALL ALLEGATIONS ARE FALSE and that it is not expanding the reach of pages with content contrary to Bill 2630 in the search, insofar as THE LARGE MAJORITY OF THE BRAZILIAN POPULATION ALSO IS CONTRARY TO THE FAKE NEWS PL.



Control, limits, obstacles, and violation of rights for Chinese user

China pioneered 5G, including the country leading the world ranking, but even with high speed, Chinese users face obstacles due to filtering and censorship in the country. The Chinese government

maintains control over China's gateways to the global internet, giving authorities the ability to restrict connectivity or access to content hosted on servers outside the country. This arrangement is the basis for the "Great Firewall", the informal name for the government's comprehensive Internet censorship system.

The Chinese government's Great Firewall is the world's most sophisticated internet censorship apparatus. Blocked content often contains criticism of individuals, policies, or events that are considered an integral part of the one-party system. The extent of censorship is constantly growing, leaving Chinese users with access only to a highly controlled, monitored, and manipulated version of the internet, freedom net says.

In addition to self-censorship so that user accounts are not closed, numerous laws are put in place that practically prevent freedom of expression and, if not complied with, judgments and hearings usually lack due process of law. It can take years for cases to move through the court system; accused are routinely denied bail and placed in long-term pre-trial detention and that of journalists is increasing by the day

JUMPING THE GREAT FIREWALL

Chinese protesters and the global internet need each other protecting a free and open internet will help support China's brave protesters.

In January 2023, many netizens circumvented China's official censorship system, known as the Great Firewall, to share information on banned platforms such as Twitter and Instagram, due to the strict rules of COVID-19, which killed at least 10 people in a fire. People across the country joined in a decentralized movement with overlapping goals, including mourning the victims of Urumqi, removing strict restrictions associated with the regime's zero COVID-19 policy, and in protest against strict political

controls.

The website "The Diplomat" also wrote that even as they battled censors on Chinese platforms, people inside the country have turned to virtual private networks (VPNs) – tools that can bypass the Great Firewall and are heavily regulated in China – to view and share uncensored content about the protests. High-profile Twitter accounts run by Chinese people living abroad acted as a stage for the dissemination of videos and photos to the general internet. On Instagram, pages that were previously dedicated to posting memes have become important repositories of information about the movement. Because of this summary of censorship in China, today Brazil has PL2630 on the agenda that could make censorship official in Brazil, if this path is traced for the country, nothing will prevent this exponential that could evolve from the point of silence, arrest and even shooting like in China.



As a matter of curiosity, China is a country that has 9,596,961 km2 of territory and 1.3 billion inhabitants, is divided into 22 provinces, five autonomous regions (Tibet is one of them), and two administrative regions, considered special. , Hong Kong and Macao.

Despite the political system in China being COMMUNIST, the economy opened up to the market and large corporations began to settle in the country. As a result, it became the second-largest economy in the world. And even though it is important on the world stage, its legal and judicial system is little known.

The judicial system adopted in China is different from that adopted in Western countries. The Chinese judicial system comprises People';s Courts, and People';s Procuratorate which is equivalent to our Public Ministry and Public Security.

THE CHINESE COURTS:

The courts can act in the criminal, administrative, and execution areas, as in Brazil. The sessions or hearings are public, obeying the principle of publicity, with exceptions in cases related to State secrecy, personal intimacy, or juvenile delinquency that run in the secrecy of justice.

Each court has a ludicial Committee, which aims to guide more complex some however, taking into account the fact that it is a communist country, where the PCC - Chinese Communist Party runs everything in the country, it does not seem to be a good idea to keep this advice that they only aim to the interests defend **Totalitarian State.**

The Chinese judiciary has Special Courts, such as the Military, Maritime, and Railway Transport, and recently the Environmental Court was also created since the pollution index of cities like Beijing reaches levels 40 (forty) times higher than the tolerable limit. As we know, the LEGAL SYSTEM of a country is very important to ensure the desired legal security for **FOREIGN** INVESTORS who invest millions in investments in China.

Therefore, contracts entered into with Western companies impose economic and legal reform on the Chinese to align their commercial purposes.

From the 1980s onwards, judges, therefore, became professional, but large still percentage are people without legal training. example, the Shanghai High Court has for some years only received judges with a degree in law and professional experience. 2008, the processes were standardized through a management process strengthening the impartiality of judges. In 2012 the Civil and Criminal Procedure Codes were updated.

The People's Attorney's Office, which is similar to the Public Prosecutor's Office in Brazil, is organized in a similar way to the courts and has the purpose of denouncing the perpetrators of crimes, exercising surveillance judicial activities, and monitoring the execution criminal court sentences. highest body is the Supreme People's Procuratorate, which supervises the procuratorates of the provinces, autonomous regions, and municipalities.

Public Security bodies administer and manage the People's Police. being maintaining responsible for public order and State security. Due to the rigidity of penalties and the authoritarianism of the government, China has a high level of security, practically zero urban violence, as happens in Brazil. Preventive measures are imposed accepted naturally the by population, an example is the search to enter public places.

Concerning HUMAN RIGHTS, China still has a lot of difficulty in dealing with these issues because of the absolutist character of its government system that imposes its will on its citizens, who, having no other option, submit.

This is the system that a short time ago, the former Minister of the Supreme Court, Ricardo Lewandowski, was visiting intending to seek information and knowledge to implement in the already so worn out and decayed BRAZILIAN JUDICIARY SYSTEM.

SUGAR AND ALCOHOL SECTOR IN BRAZIL

THE GIANT THAT NEEDS INNOVATION



The world sugarcane market should reach around 6.70 billion dollars by 2027. According to CONAB, the current sugarcane plantation area in Brazil is 8,410.3 thousand hectares, about 1.5 % higher than in the previous harvest, with a forecast crushing of 637,092.6 thousand tons in the season, pointing to a growth of 4.4%, and which should generate 38.77 million tons of sugar and 27.53 billion liters of ethanol in the 2023/24 harvest. The sugar and alcohol sector is still responsible for approximately 800,000 direct jobs divided among the 330 Brazilian mills and accounts for almost 15% of the countrys exports.

In this context, the size of this market is evident. The sectors difficulties are proportionally equivalent to its size, as we will analyze in this article. The sugar and alcohol sector feels more strongly some difficulties common to Brazilian companies, such as lack of investment, problems with succession, climatic seasonality, and raw material supply.

>>> INNOVATION

1. Investment in innovation and technology: many sugarcane-based production processes are already part of studies and development of new technologies, such as the genetic improvement of plants and the expansion of plantation size per area, but much remains to be done can be improved in the production system through improvements in the plants themselves, from management to the development of more modern systems, equipment and machinery that optimize the production process.

>>> INVESTMENT

2. Investment in the intermodal system: production logistics in Brazil are carried out by road system. In a country with 42,000 km of navigable rivers, 30,000 km of railways, and 2,463 airports and airfields, there is much to be developed to expand the performance and improve the Brazilian intermodal system.

>>> SOIL NUTRIENTS

3. Investment in increased production: Brazil is a country of continental proportions, which still has much to be improved in terms of increasing production, whether in the development of new technologies for existing areas or in the development of new areas for cultivation, without offering risks to the production of other foodstuffs, given the large availability of arable land in Brazil.

The prospects for the Brazilian sugar and alcohol sector are very good if due importance is given to the generation of new technologies and the modernization of the sector, both to achieve growth in production levels and to improve the financial health of the mills, thus guaranteeing increasingly better results for Brazil and the world.

INNOVATION TO REINDUSTRIALIZE BRAZIL

It is a recurring statement among businessmen, also always present in political agendas, common

even in everyday conversations: to Brazil needs "reindustrialized". If it is a fact that the Brazilian industry has lost much of its strength in recent times, hence the convergence of opinions regarding the need to restructure this sector, the debate plunges into divergence when it comes to how this should be done. This is because some themes, such as the role of the state or private investment in the industrial sector, as well as the use of more or less protectionist models for domestic industrial production, as well as and legal security regulatoru issues, end up permeating the discussion. But even here, among voices, dissenting we find common belief that any proposal for reindustrialization will be unfeasible without taking innovation into account.





Initially, before dealing with innovation, let us consider the dimension of the challenge. IBGE data indicate that, in the 2010s, industrial production shrank by 20%. The sector's participation in the Brazilian GDP decreased by 33% from 2010 to 2021, and there was a loss of around 800,000 jobs.

These are numbers released in 2022, even contemplating the problematic scenario of the pandemic, but this deindustrialization has been taking place since the 1980s and 1990s in our country, due tov arious causes, whether in the external or internal environment. Some of them were pointed out by José Augusto Fernandes, an associate researcher at the Center for Integration and Development Studies (Cindes), in an interview published by the Economic Conjuncture Blog of FGV/IBRE, when asked about some statements by the about new government reindustrializing the country:

There are factors ranging from the macro environment at various times in the Brazilian economy over the last 40 years to the structural transformation of the entry of China, Eastern Europe, and Russia into the market economy. In this context of the entry of new competitors, and with the development of value chains, Brazil found it difficult to design its policies in this new environment. That is when Brazil explored intensive local content policies without paying attention to the effects on the overall productivity of the economy, it came at a cost. When Brazil maintained a protection structure that was still very high when compared to other emerging countries, including India, this increased the connection difficulty. When it did not adequately invest in different logistics systems to plug in with this environment, it also created an additional difficulty. And the multinational companies, which are the protagonists of this process, look at the world and do not identify Brazilian geography as privileged either. (...) Our tax system is very cumulative, so it penalizes the investment rate and exports.



Other issues interfered with the process of continuous deindustrialization in Brazil in recent decades, such as high-interest rates, legal and regulatory uncertainty that keeps foreign investment away, and a succession of governments that have not invested in infrastructure, without even looking at the external environment.

Faced with this monumental task, innovation is a concept that is very present in the discussions. What is, or rather, what is the innovation that we intend as representatives of the sector and which we believe is the path to the success of the undertaking?

We could embark on an academic path and bring studies, articles, definitions, and distinctions (product innovation, process innovation, business innovation, open innovation, to name just a few examples), and it may even be opportune to make this conceptualization more detailed on another occasion, but, in this brief text, our objective is more modest and aims at all citizens as readers, in addition to a debate between companies and other players in the industrial sector. We want to think about the country and design an ideal country. Prosperous, with economic development, without losing sight of social justice; with a fertile environment for the development of scientific minds, and an attractive one for the permanence of these minds in our territory, in a continuous cycle of development.

Therefore, it is essential to think about innovation in a context of updating, of finally bringing the 21st century to Brazilian industry, considering sustainability issues, the internet of things, among other aspects of the digital revolution, decarbonization, that is, an agenda that does not repeat models already tested and failed, but, on the contrary, turn to the use of science and technology as foundations for the construction of the new Brazil that we want.

As we see it, innovation will be investing in automation, bearing in mind the new configurations of the labor market, with less and less manpower available for "factory floor" functions. Innovating will ensure excellence in education, training, and maintaining a contingent of researchers, scientists, and technicians who can always feed back efforts to create innovative technologies and processes.

Innovation will be to ensure that all this occurs with proper regulation regarding waste, environmental issues, and sustainability. Innovation, in Brazil, will involve facing reindustrialization within a larger panorama, of social justice, and enrichment of the population in financial terms, but also terms of culture, education, and awareness of their rights and duties as citizens of a large developed nation.

This industrialized, developed nation with high levels of human development is just around the corner, if there modernization of different systems (economic, business, educational, etc.), together with significant and intelligent investment in innovation, in a transparent way, either through public or private power, but that happens without repeating practices that slide into interference and corruption. This is also innovating, building a new mentality and business environment in the country. At the risk of being repetitive, I conclude by highlighting once again the enormity of the challenge, but, above all, reinforcing our belief in the enormous potential of our industry, our people, and our country.






THE FINANCIAL SYSTEM AND THE WORLD CRISIS

The Brazilian National Financial System was created in 1808, with the arrival of the Portuguese Royal family in Brazil. At this time, the two main Brazilian state banks appeared, Banco do Brasil in 1809 and Caixa Econômica Federal in 1931.

The Financial System as we know it began in 1944 at the end of World War II when the Bretton Woods Conference was held, including the Brazilian participation, such an event becomes the landmark of the world economic organization.

The Bretton Woods system ended in 1971, when the US abandoned its gold backing and the value of currencies began to fluctuate with exchange rates. But the institutions stayed and became pillars of post-Cold War globalization, from 1990 onwards.



During the first wave of modernization and globalization of the economy in the 19th century, this evolution was marked by the creation of central banks, multilateral treaties, and intergovernmental organizations to improve the transparency of operations and the effectiveness of markets. What happened was the opposite, one observes the blatant manipulation and absolute control of some families that control central banks around the world and, therefore, have the power to decide the course of the economy, politics, and worse, yet, now they want to control even your life.

In 1973, SISTEMA SWIFT was created, an acronym for Society for Worldwide Interbank Financial Telecommunication, which means Society for Worldwide Interbank Financial Telecommunication Service. Through this banking system, communication between banks around the world is possible,

enabling the transfer of services and values between any location on the planet that uses this system, its headquarters are in Belgium. The concept of an International Financial System (IFS) is the exchange or business relationship between currencies, activities, monetary and financial flows, international financial loans, payments, and investments, companies, banks. central banks. governments, or organizations. As such, the World Financial System is controlled by both the IMF and the World Bank and has institutional relationships with the G10, BIS Bank for Institutional Relations as they control ALL loans, short and longterm, worldwide as shown below.

The FInancial **System Problems**

To the surprise of many these years in Davos, the President of the IMF -International Monetary Fund Kristalina Gueorguieva announced at the annual meeting in January that in 2023 the world should reach the height of the global recession.

The world's leading economists expect a global recession generated by the COVID-19 pandemic and geopolitical tensions to lead the United States to an unprecedented crisis in the year 2023.

The first signs of this effect have already been observed in the United States with the crisis of the Silicon Valley Banks and others that follow the same path. The US government is stepping in to try to save the world's largest economy.

According experts, this crisis tο specific presents а context: deindustrialization of many countries, caused and accelerated mainly by the globalization of trade and, secondly, by financial deregulation.





Crises always arise in times of economic slowdown, as we see today, marked by world conflicts and the threat of pandemics.

At the G7 we see France, Germany, and the United Kingdom impacted ongoing energy crisis. In the United States, it is different, never seen such highinterest rates corroborating with the bank crisis.

China is also going through a historic real estate downturn. Everything indicates that moment of crisis should the throughout year measures are taken governments to contain inflation and the market returns operating at the levels previously practiced.

HOW CHINA WILL BECOME THE WORLD'S LARGEST GDP AND HOW THE US AND EU TRY TO RESIST RUSSIA

Since the outbreak of the conflict between Russia and Ukraine, both the United States and the main countries of the European Union have been trying to avoid and circumvent a direct entry into the warlike conflagration. Particularly at this point, not even NATO landed directly on Ukrainian territory, but has been supplying all war supplies and equipment to support Ukraine, together with the US, UK, and other EU countries.

The way that the USA and the EU chose to participate in the conflict, as the whole world knows, was through commercial means. In the specific interest of this article, one of the strongest sanctions they considered and applied was the boycott of Russian oil and natural gas.

However, sanctions along these lines are causing the US people a great deal of trouble: the boycott is very wrong. To maintain it, in several recent opportunities, the USA had to practically zero the stocks of oil and natural gas that it held and is going out to purchase commodities in the world markets – from what has been seen in the news, lately they are prospecting the purchase of 3 million barrels of oil to replenish at least part of these depleted stocks. The consequences that the whole world is suffering (including the US) were the rise in oil and natural gas prices, as well as the maintenance of these prices at historically high levels.

And there is a detail that many have not noticed: although the main countries of the European Union were boycotting Russian oil and natural gas they began to conveniently buy Russian oil and natural gas through India.

Currently, not only has the amount of oil and natural gas produced and traded by Russia not fallen, but it has increased immensely. All these commercial operations are done "behind the scenes", in disguise. To evaluate them, it is necessary to verify the points of trade, the origin of production, and the recipients of the products. From this, it turns out that before 2015, Russia's economy was in the top ten of the world. It is thought that since 2015 Russia's economy has been in decline, and this seemed to be happening even before the Russia-Ukraine conflict. Interestingly, after the outbreak of conflict, Russia's economy improved compared to the situation it had in 2015. Russian GDP in 2015 was US\$ 1.363 trillion, while in 2022 it was US\$ 1.742 trillion. Even with the drop (-2.1%) seen in 2022 compared to 2021, which certainly resulted from the outbreak of the conflict, the Russian economy, since then, seems to have improved, and not fallen abruptly (as expected). The estimate for 2023, by the Austing Rate, is that it will reach US\$ 1,833.3 trillion, with conflict and all.

So, looking at the economic picture of India, we found some very interesting things. Currently, India is a transit point, a warehouse for Russian natural gas, and EU countries buy Russian gas under the Indian brand of natural gas in India. The same is happening with oil: New Delhi is increasingly buying cheap Russian oil, refining it, and selling it to the European Union and the US. Just by way of illustration, India shipped 89,000 barrels/day of gasoline and diesel to New York in January 2023, the highest number in almost four years, according to the Kpler consultancy.

Daily flows of low-sulfur diesel to Europe were 172,000 barrels in the same month, the highest number since 2021. All of this is in line with EU standards and guidelines.

When (Russian) oil is processed into fuels in a non-EU country such as India, the refined products can be sold to the EU because they are not considered to be of Russian origin. In other words: Russia is selling a lot of oil to India, which extracts the derivatives and sells them all over the world. The volume is such that, more recently (May 2023), the EU's Head of Diplomacy, Josep Barrel, suggested the hypothesis of an embargo on Indian oil derivatives, which still cast doubt on the real volumes of Russian crude oil that are being bought by India.

At this point, many will remember that OPEC+, of which Russia is a member, has determined more than one cut in oil production, in an attempt to keep the price of the commodity high. Nominally, Russia's output cut last April was close to the promised target of 443,000 barrels per day.

Russia's Energy Ministry said the country'; soil production cuts in April had almost reached the target level. The Kremlin pledged in March to cut oil output by 500,000 bpd and hold until December in response to Western restrictions, including price caps imposed by the G-7. Crude oil flows into ports, however, have so far shown little sign of a production cut. Energy Ministry data showed that Russia's average daily crude oil production in April was 1.319 million tons, which equals 9.67 million barrels per day, at a conversion rate of 7.33 barrels per ton, which means it was lower than the basic production cut in February. So the oil that India is getting could be coming from elsewhere. A tip: Russia recently inaugurated 3,000 km of railways connecting it with Iran, precisely for international oil trade... Is there a trade triangulation there?

In short: the EU supports the US on the surface but secretly buys crazy Russian oil and natural gas!

Trade between Russia and India is so voluminous that, recently, there were international negotiations in the sense of defining one of the currencies as the basis for the flow. India wanted it to be the rupee, and Russia wanted it to be the ruble. At the end of the story, there was no deal. So, the currency they are using is the yuan...




On the other side of the coin, even though they are in conflict, Ukraine plans to increase tariffs on Russian oil transported from its territory to Europe through the "Friendship" pipeline. Ukraine wants to gradually increase the tariff on a tonne of oil to 21 euros (\$23.11) from the current 13.60 euros on Aug. 1, the report said. Pricing agency Argus and market sources say tariffs could rise by 25% to 17 euros a tonne from 1 June and another 23.5% to 21 euros a from 1 August. EUR. Ukrainian pipeline Ukrtransnafta and Russia's energy ministry did not immediately respond to requests for comment. You can imagine whether the status of the United States will be greatly shaken if this continues... And this shock, of course, will slide into the dollar. Currently, there is still a common currency in Russia, and now it seems that in India, namely China's RMB, the famous yuan.

The United States practically cut Russia out of the SWIFT system and applied sanctions in several respects.

- 1: All US and EU companies investing in Russia withdrew, causing Russian workers to lose their jobs and hijacking income from the Russian economy;
- 2: The United States boycotts energy from Russia in general;
- 3: Making it difficult or excluding Russia's access to the SWIFT system makes it impossible to pay or receive Russian currency.

The idea of the United States is to sell its energy, of course, but at this moment, American investors are sitting on the floor and raising the price, quadrupling the amount of energy, while practically zeroing out inventories. On the other hand, Russia's low price sales, at US\$ 20/barrel of oil, makes the Russian product very attractive. As a result, Russia joined China Union Pay, an international payment system led by China that, of course, uses the renminbi (yuan) as a reference currency. Add to this picture the recent moves by China to strengthen diplomatic ties with the countries of Central Asia (Uzbekistan, Kazakhstan, Turkmenistan, etc., which have always been considered

"Russia's backyard), precisely in search of coal, oil, and gas. Through this so-called "energy cooperation" with more countries in the world, the Asian giant is expanding commercial markets, which provides important support for China's economic development. In this sense, the prediction of Austin Rating: in 2034 (at the latest) the Chinese GDP will surpass that of the USA, becoming the world's largest economy.

CURIOSITY ABOUT THIS SYMPHONY

Symphony No. 8 in E flat major is one of the greatest choral works in the classical repertoire. Its orchestration requires soloists, a chorus, and a large orchestra.

The vocal and choral staff is made up of eight soloists (3 sopranos, 2 alto, tenor, baritone, and bass), a children's choir, and 2 mixed choirs. The instrumental forces comprise a piccolo, 4 flutes, 4 oboes, an English horn, 5 clarinets. а clarinet. 4 bassoons. 8 horns, 10 trumpets, contrabassoon, trombones, tuba, timpani, drum, cymbals, gong, triangle, bells, carillon, celesta, mandolins, piano, harmonium, 2 harps, strings, and organ. Mahler used the ninth-century Latin hymn Veni Creator Spiritus in the first of the work's two movements and the final Goethe's scene of Faust in the second movement.

CONTEMPORARY MUSIC

Since the 20th century, the world has changed in every way. Technological advances, along with the proliferation of radio and television, as well as devices for recording, editing, reproducing, and sharing sound, have changed the way society interacts with music.

Furthermore, the last 100 years have been characterized by musical experimentation and the emergence of new genres in both classical and pop culture, challenging previous paradigms and offering innovations in music.

There is no single trend in contemporary music. However, two trends can be mentioned: avant-garde music, which mainly includes experimentalism, and the neoclassical and neo-romantic direction (so-called conservatives), marked by composers such as Arvo Pärt and Krzysztof Penderecki. it represents a reaction to experimentation and a return to tonal language. Although there is still a lot of prejudice about it, as with the emergence of new artistic trends, it is also possible to highlight the electronic music created in Germany in the 1950s, responsible for the birth of completely new and strange sounds. electronically generated or manipulated by others. instruments or objects incorporated into music and widely studied. Modern music has, especially valued innovation and creativity.



Impressionism (1910-1920), dominated by French composers, is probably the beginning of modern music. Among the various types of contemporary music, electronic music stands out (that which is created or transformed with electronic devices and instruments such as synthesizers, digital recorders, computers, or music composition software); and incidental music, which, as the name suggests, is the responsibility of the performing musician, who in some cases only has to submit to a more general idea that inspires the music, an emotion or a historical event, but which still requires an enormous musical talent, imagination, and creativity.

Among the most important composers of contemporary music include: Considered one of the greatest composers of the late 20th century, Karlheinz Stockhausen's works changed the concept of rhythm, melody, and harmony. Among his most daring works is the Helicopter String Quartet (Helikopter-Streichquartett in German), actually interpreted by a string quartet and four helicopters, the result of more than ten years of work; and the opera Licht, based on Sanskrit and Buddhist texts divided into sections based on the days of the week.

At the end of the coronation procession, the King and Queen appeared on the balcony of Buckingham Palace. Then the Royal Air Force appeared in

the sky over London.

EDUCATION IN CHINA



Chinese education has many peculiarities that may surprise those who don't know the country yet. Unlike Brazil, China's educational system upholds three important values, which are discipline, patriotism, and selectivity. The country ranked first in PISA 2018 thanks to its very rigorous and selective teaching.

The primary school has children from 6 to 11 years old. To enter high school, students take the Xiaokao exam. After three years, they can choose a vocational school and quickly find a job. However, this is not a very common decision.

Most students take the entrance exam, Zhong Kao. Then, at the end of high school, the great national entrance exam, the gāokao, takes place. China's education system is hyper-selective, and each cycle is entered through an exam.

Day by day in schools

The school year in China is divided into two semesters starting on September 1st and March 1st respectively. The semesters are separated by a month of vacation each: February (for the Chinese New Year celebration - celebrated with family) and June.

During the school year, classes are from Monday to Saturday. On Monday mornings, before the first class, students and teachers gather to raise the flag and sing the national anthem. Everyone must be in uniform and wear a red scarf. In addition, there are also daily physical exercises and moments of relaxation and massages in some schools. After the last night's classes, students clean the classrooms (dust, blackboard, desks, windows, and floor).

From elementary school onwards, there are daily classes in Chinese, math, and English. Children also attend a mandatory course on communist ideology and morals. Classes are usually short, up to 35 minutes, and teachers only teach one concept at a time. If you are interested, be sure to read about the Shanghai method.

Another strength of Chinese education is mathematics and precision fields. Therefore, in 2018, the Asian country was considered the best in mathematics according to PISA (Programme for International Student Assessment). Furthermore, Chinese provinces occupy three of the top four places:

- 1. Beijing, Shanghai, Jiangsu, and Guangdong (China);
- 2. Singapore;
- 3. Macao (China);
- 4. Hong Kong (China).

ACCESS TO EDUCATION

According to the Chinese constitution, all citizens are entitled to compulsory and free education for 9 years. That's why school is until the end of high free school. Furthermore, few children in poor rural beyond secondary areas go because, although it is free, extra costs (books, transport, and uniform) and food costs can undermine education. Therefore, the poorest families receive support, but it is still not necessarily enough to cover their children's educational costs.



PRIVATE SCHOOLS

High schools are called "Noble Institutes" (Guizu Xuexiao) and offer excellent education. Because of

the high costs, only children from wealthy families can participate, and scholarships are rare.

In China, the study of three subjects dominates widely: Chinese, Mathematics, and English.

The country is 16th on the 2023 World Persecution List, which ranks the 23 that countries most persecute Christians in the world. Tightening and increased restrictions surveillance are putting Christians in China under intense pressure as the Communist Party seeks to limit all threats to power. Surveillance in China is among the most oppressive and sophisticated in the world, and Christian leaders are particularly vulnerable to persecution, including imprisonment or, in a small number of cases, kidnapping.

New restrictions on the internet and social media — along with the 2018 religion regulations, which continue to be revised — are placing severe limitations on Christians freedom. Many churches are being monitored and closed, no matter if they are independent or belong to the Three-Self Movement Patriotic officially state-sanctioned Protestant church in China). It remains illegal for anyone under 18 to attend church. The old idea that churches will only be perceived as a threat if they become too large, political, or invite outsiders is now an unreliable guideline.

If a convert from Islam or Tibetan Buddhism is discovered by the family or community, they are often threatened or physically assaulted—all to get them back to their original faith. Neighbors can report any Christian activity to the authorities or village chief, who must act to stop the Christians.

Who is most vulnerable to persecution in China?

Converts from a Muslim or Buddhist background likely face the strongest persecution in China. Persecution comes from families and local communities. Protestant Christians are most concentrated in Henan provinces, and Zhejiana Catholic Christians are numerous in Hebei. All these can be considered points of attention for the chase. However, Christians face restrictions and monitoring across China, with incidents reported in nearly every province.



Chinese Christian Ex-Muslims are Biblically Empowered through Open Doors Discipleship Imagine growing up in China. You are from a mainly Muslim group, but your family is Christian. You keep it a secret, after all some people don't like Christians. But one day, someone finds out. A friend's father shows up at her house yelling at her father. You can no longer see that family as they are seen as enemies now. That's what happened to Kamila*. For ex-Muslim Christians like her, rejection from family and friends is commonplace. "When Muslims put their faith in Jesus, they are often marginalized, disowned by family, and rejected by friends," explains Pearl*, an Open Doors contributor who works Christian ex-Muslims in China.

Kamila is blessed to have Christian family. "It's a little easier to live as an ex-Muslim Christian if the whole family converts," says Pearl. If they are found with Bibles and Christian materials or sharing the gospel, they could receive a serious warning, fined, detained, or even imprisoned."

Open Doors estimates that there are only five or six thousand former Muslim Christians in China. And call out to our brothers and sisters to share God';s love with their neighbors.

IMMUNITY AND FOOD!

We are exposed at all times to various types of agents that transmit diseases such as flu, colds, and infections. Our immune system must be well prepared to protect us from these agents. Several factors can help or hinder the proper functioning of your defense system. Some actions are important to boost immunity and ensure that your body is up to date with its natural defenses. I will list some of them for you to follow and keep your body healthy.

Vitamin A is important to include in your diet. It directly participates in the formation of defense cells, known as antibodies. It is found in foods of animal origin such as liver, milk, cheese, yogurt, and eggs, some types of poultry, fruits, and vegetables, especially dark green ones (spinach, cabbage, arugula), and orange ones such as carrots, beets, tomatoes, pumpkin, and mango)

Vitamin C is an ally of immunity, due to its great antioxidant power, that is, it fights free radicals, compounds that pose a great risk to the health of the body's cells. The mineral can be found in citrus fruits, such as pineapple, orange, lemon, acerola, and guava. Vegetables like kale and broccoli also have plenty of this vitamin. Abuse them in the preparation of shots and other recipes.

Do not give up on Vitamin D, known as the sunshine vitamin, it is important for boosting immunity because it activates cell proliferation, including immune cells. It is found in fatty fish (salmon, tuna), fish oils, eggs, mushrooms, milk, and derivatives. Sunbathing in the right way is also recommended for the formation of Vitamin D.

Another tip is to include food sources of zinc in the diet. This mineral is essential as it participates in the development of the body's defense system. It is found in beef, pork, fish and poultry, brown rice, chickpeas, peas, cheeses, and nuts.

Omega 3 supplementation is also when interesting it comes strengthening the immune system because it reduces inflammation in the body. The main sources of omega 3 are seafood in general, but mainly sardines. (tuna, salmon), vegetable oils such as olive oil, canola, and sunflower, and seeds such as chia flaxseed. Another important action is to take care of the intestine. More than half of the immune system cells are there, you know?

That's why it's essential to keep it running smoothly. In addition, the absorption of everything we eat is done in the intestine, if the organ is not healthy, vitamins, minerals, and other nutrients are not absorbed, and in this way, the body will not receive the "fuel" it needs to strengthen itself.

For the best functioning of the intestine, invest in fibers (whole grains, legumes such as beans, chickpeas, and lentils), vegetables, fruits, seeds, and prebiotic foods such as onion, garlic, green banana and probiotics such as fermented milk drinks, kombucha, kefir, etc. avoid refined carbohydrates such as pieces of bread, cakes, cookies made with white flour, as these foods increase harmful bacteria in the intestine, causing the microbiota to become unbalanced.

Another villain of the immune system is alcoholic beverages. Alcohol disrupts the performance of defense cells, and neutrophils, which become less efficient in combating infectious and inflammatory agents. Therefore, they should be avoided or consumed with a conscience.

Another important point to note is the quality of your sleep. While we are sleeping, the body works making adjustments necessary for the balance of the immune system. The recommendation is to sleep 6 to 8 hours a day. And don't stand still! Do some kind of physical activity. Hiking, running, sport, dancing... any movement is very good for immunity. Some studies have shown that the practice of exercise has a positive effect on the immune system, reducing the occurrence of infections.

These were some of the important guidelines for taking care of your health and leaving your immune system super active and efficient. Now that you know the importance of a balanced diet and the adoption of new habits, how about putting these actions into practice?
