





"... for 37 generations the Jews were not the majority in the land of Israel. For the last 3 generations, we have been the majority in the land of Israel. We have a country to call ours."


"... we have to continue working, hard, so that the next 40 generations continue to exist in the land of Israel..."

Mosab Hassan Yousef lived behind the scenes of the Islamic fundamentalist group Hamas and witnessed the political and military maneuvers that contributed to intensifying the bloody dispute in the Middle East. As he was the eldest son of Sheikh Hassan Yousef, one of the founders of the organization, everyone believed that he would follow in his father's footsteps.

After being captured and tortured by the Israeli Intelligence Service, he was recruited to be an informant for Israel for nearly a decade, operating at the highest levels of Hamas. Mosab was given the code name "The Green Prince" by his employees at the Shin Bet internal intelligence agency, according to the Haaretz newspaper.

Yousef moved to the United States and became a pariah when the first draft of his book The Son of Hamas was released. No government would offer him political asylum, the Israeli government would not recognize his work and no church would welcome him. He would eventually receive asylum from the American government, gained recognition for his work from Israel, and now resides in the US.

ANTISEMITISM IN BRAZIL



The word 'anti-Semitism' means prejudice against or hatred of Jews. The Holocaust is the most radical example of anti-Semitism in history. Supported by the government, the German Nazis and their collaborators persecuted and exterminated two-thirds of Europe's Jews between 1933 and 1945.

Anti-Semitism in Brazil is made up of racist manifestations, of a religious, ideological, and/or political nature, against the Jewish people, which have occurred throughout Brazilian history.

According to CONIB (Confederação Israelita do Brasil), in 2022, 496 total records were received through the Department of Community Security's reporting channels. However, not all of them are considered anti-Semitism and this number also includes repeated registrations, that is, the same complaint received more than once.

Most of the complaints were received through the channels available on the WhatsApp communication application, via email, and the contact channel on the CONIB website. Some complaints were received on social media, mainly Instagram.

After analyzing and classifying all the records received and discarding repetitions, we reached the number of 385 relevant reports of anti-Semitism, that is, 78% of the total, and these, 283 classified in the were categories previously presented: anti-Semitism understood as racism, Nazism, and denial/trivialization of the Holocaust, representing 73.5% of reports of anti-Semitism and 57% of the total received

Complaints classified as anti-Semitism understood as racism are those in which hatred towards Jews is expressed due to a perceived

wrong and prejudiced view of Judaism and the Jewish people and is permeated by fanciful ideas, sometimes of Jewish control of important segments of society or the world, sometimes of actions of pettiness and avarice in the underworld to take personal advantage.

As an example of occurrences, it is worth highlighting what happened at the Jewish Museum in São Paulo, when a young man painted a swastika on the glass of the institution and then gave the Nazi salute.

Or, when a boy wearing a t-shirt with an Attomwaffen Division skull on it gives a Nazi salute, shouts "heil Hitler" and praises the Aryan race while showing a knife to the people around him. And also several Nazi graffiti on a university in the State of There is even a channel on the Telegram communication application entitled "Brazilian Anti-Semitic Movement", with 103 subscribers.

Concerning actions to combat anti-Semitism, when a complaint of anti-Semitism is received, the legal commission carries out an analysis of the typical appropriateness of the conduct. In the case of conduct considered criminal, especially a crime of racism, the case is taken to the competent authorities for investigation and punishment of those responsible, by the law.

In the event of the initiation of a criminal case, CONIB has qualified as an assistant to the prosecution in several cases involving crimes of racism and racial insults, obtaining relevant convictions and valuable precedents in the fight against hate speech.

There is no possible comparison or equivalence between the Holocaust and the current events. The term "Holocaust" specifically refers to the extermination by the Nazis of Jews, people with disabilities, homosexuals, black people, gypsies, and other populations they considered inferior.

around 1500 AD, when vessels coming from Portugal to colonize this newly discovered territory brought slaves from Spain, Europe, and even from Portugal, these were Jewish refugees, taking into account the several times that Israel was invaded, looted and its people dispersed throughout the world.

The trajectory of Jews in Brazil begins even before the arrival of Cabral's fleet: it begins at the end of the 15th century when Spanish and Portuguese Jews were forced to convert to Christianity, under penalty of being expelled from their respective countries.

In Spain, in 1492, the first large Jewish migration movement emerged, that of the Sephardim. They left the country after the decree signed by the "Catholic Kings" Isabel I of Castella and Fernando Aragon, expelling those who had not converted to Christianity. They then headed towards the Ottoman Empire, the Polish and Russian steppes, Morocco, and crossed the border towards Portugal.

From Portugal, from 1540 onwards, New Christians and, mainly, those who still maintained Jewish religious practices, intensified their efforts to emigrate to the New World.

At that time, Portugal was just beginning to colonize the discovered lands.

Others say that this bond began around 1947, when the nation of Israel was recognized internationally, in a vote at the United Nations General Assembly, chaired by Brazilian diplomat Oswaldo Aranha, who gave his decisive and favorable vote for the creation of the nation, and that almost a year after that historical moment, in May 1948 the Nation of Israel definitely had its existential beginning.



In general, there are two prominent religions in Brazil, the ROMAN CATHOLIC and the Evangelical churches. While Catholicism is structured into "Religious Orders" under the direction of a visible head, the other Christian churches are presented in "Denominations", all, however, as a single base, the Holy Bible. The distances between Catholic "Religious Orders" resemble the distance between Evangelical denominations with rare exceptions. It is also noted that Catholics and Evangelicals believe in the Holy Trinity, God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit; share the doctrine that Christ is the Savior by his substitutionary death; Both churches teach the existence of Heaven and Hell and accept the same Bible as the Word of God.

CATHOLICISM began to take shape in the year 325 when the Roman emperor Constantine "converted" Christianity called the First Council of churches which was led by Osio Córdova with 318 bishops present, these bishops were Christians, there was still no Roman Catholicism. -Constantine built the CHURCH OF SAVIOR THE in an upscale neighborhood of Rome called Vaticanus, the bishops (popes) of the time built several palaces around the church forming the Vatican that exists today. The Church received the name Catholic only in the year 381, at the council of Constantinople with the "CUNCTOS POPULOS' directed by the Roman emperor Theodosius.

In any case, through genealogical roots, peace treaties, and diplomatic influences, and even due to the religious context, Brazil has in its records and origins a strong influence and rapprochement with Judaism.

Denying this is at least ignorant if we are descendants, politically involved, and still profess the majority of the same faith and religious practices, originating, even if adapted to the Brazilian civil context, defending Israel, the Jews, and their existence, becomes an obligation.


TAX REFORM

The long-awaited tax reform that Brazil needs, or needed, with the simplification of taxes, better distribution between federative entities, deconcentration of collection,

We achieved something surreal. We created a contraption. We managed to do something almost unimaginable. Even in our worst nightmares, we would not imagine such irresponsibility and political casuistry. It's a clear demonstration that nothing is so bad that it can't get worse. In short, a model was created that involves an increase in public spending, an increase litigation, and, above all. αn immense fiscal injustice in total non-compliance with the principle of ability to pay.

In this sense, the reform will invariably increase the tax burden. Welcome to the chaos.



Furthermore, ill-fated exceptions were created, which interfered with the percentage of the standard VAT (Value Added Tax) rate. The more exceptions are opened, the more the rate will increase. So. intended whoever benefit will reached now be by themselves.

Finally, no less perverse, the creation of a selective tax, which appears as a way of discouraging the consumption of goods and services that are harmful to health or the environment – a practice observed in several countries around the world – brings with it several questions, for example, Example: Are eggs bad for your health? Should it be taxed or not? Is beer a sin? Does beer cause physical and psychological dependence? Well, everything will depend on your doctor.

Invariably, someone will pay the bill for the fiscal imbalance achieved by the reform, otherwise let's see:

- 1. Differentiated rates 60% reduction for the road and subway public transport sectors, national artistic, cultural, journalistic, and audiovisual productions, sporting activities and institutional communication; food intended for human consumption, personal hygiene and cleaning products consumed by low-income families:
- 2.Intermediate rate 30% for the provision of services by regulated professions, the so-called independent professionals;
- State funds maintained until December 31, 2032;
- 4. Automotive sector extends benefits until the end of 2032;

Change won in Argentina: the then right-wing candidate, 53-year-old economist Javier Gerardo Milei, was elected president with 55.7%, that is, there were almost 15 million votes against 44.3%, a little more than 11.5 million votes for the left-wing candidate and current economy minister, the Peronist Sérgio Massa. In addition to emerging victorious in the election, Milei also became the best-voted politician in history. He had the highest number of votes in the capital Buenos Aires, in addition to winning in 20 of the 23 Argentine provinces. His opponent Sérgio Massa even lost in his electoral stronghold, the city of Tigres north of Buenos Aires where he was mayor twice. The results of the elections were reported by the Dirección Nacional Electoral Argentino.

Campaign Speeches, Goals and Proposals

A campaign marked by fiery speeches the most important said to be election of the last 100 years. There were accusations of possible risk of electoral fraud. The candidate's team filed a formal complaint with the country's electoral court, including asking for measures to guarantee the transparency of the elections. The then-candidate. Javier explained that, due to the theft of ballots that his party suffered, there were polling stations where received zero votes in the previous elections. Another curious fact is about a report of a possible invasion of the electronic electoral system used in Argentine elections. According to his party La Libertad Avanza, there was a group of users could enter the who electronic system, so an electoral prosecutor opened an investigation, but asked the party to present evidence of possible electoral fraud.

Anarcho-capitalism is a political and economic doctrine that provides for the adoption of libertarian ethics, free market theories and the complete absence of administrative centralization of the State and tax collection

Milei calls himself an "anarchocapitalist", in favor of capitalism and the free market. His statements gained strength in poorer regions of Argentina that show some dissatisfaction with the current policy in the country. Among his main ideas and campaign proposals, he stated that by winning the elections, he would leave the Mercosur group and would not have commercial relations with Lula's Brazil (Workers' Party), calling him communist and corrupt. During his campaign, he talked about downsizing the public sector. reducing the current ministries 8. eliminating to ministries such as Women, Gender, and Diversity, in addition to strongly wanting the privatization of public companies across the country.

In the economy, he mentioned the removal of current restrictions on the purchase and sale of dollars that have been in place since the end of Macri's government in 2019, one of the measures to begin the process dollarization of the economy, addition to defending the closure of the Central Bank in Argentina. In the sphere of work, he proposes a reform to make contracts more flexible, and reduce employer contributions and the tax burden on workers, in addition to limiting the current power of unions. In education. has the he idea improving public education and health systems, making services privately managed, and has plans to review the different types of direct social assistance. Milei campaigned against abortion, a practice regulated Argentina, and will fight to change the current legislation. In national security, he talks about the deregulation of the firearms market, banning the entry of foreigners who have a criminal record, and even the deportation of those who commit crimes. In the prison system, he even promised build to penitentiaries in the public-private restructure model. them. and eliminate the aid he currently has for inmates

Miller's victory and the impact on Brazil

We cannot deny that the victory is not only for the Argentine people but also for the right in South America. This victory frustrates the plan of the "left wave" and thus, four South American countries will now be governed by leaders from the right-wing executive: Ecuador. Paraguay, Uruguay. and now Argentina. Visualizing this situation, we see that Brazil, the country with the largest GDP (Gross Domestic Product) in the region, contributing almost 55% of regional production together with its neighbor, Argentina, the second largest economy in South America Brazil's and the third largest commercial partner, have mutual influence if a government with more left or right thinking wins an election. One of the biggest challenges is the lack of dialogue between the two presidents, where bilateral trade between Brazil and Argentina could be seriously compromised. Perhaps, due to the good relationship between the two countries over the years, there is a consensus among the leaders of South American nations. remembering that negotiating with left-wing governments will not always be a good deal.

Islam and the 5th REICH

The Islamic movement around the world, with Muslim countries in the Middle East supporting Palestine, reminds us of the Second World War. In the beginning, the Axis alliance was Germany, Italy and Japan. These countries were led by German dictator Adolf Hitler, the Italian dictator Benito Mussolini and the Japanese emperor, Hirohito. In September 1940, the three countries formalized their alliance through a Tripartite Five other countries Pact. subsequently joined Tripartite Pact, also becoming Axis allied powers. They were: Bulgaria, Croatia, Hungary, Romania and Slovakia.

Each of the six European Axis powers, allied with Germany, participated in the Holocaust by murdering Jews or transferring them to German custody to be murdered by it.

The largest concentration of lews was in countries that did side with the Nazis. not Poland. Lithuania. Ukraine, which were not part of the Axis but were quickly dominated by the Germans, and the majority who did not sympathize with the facilitated the surrender and genocide. The Nazis saw Poland as a sub-race.

In parallel, Iran, which belongs to non-Arab countries, sees Arab countries as a sub-race, even though it is a threat to Arab countries, its hatred of Jews is greater than its resistance to Iran, which facilitates extermination.



New Axis

Given the current scenario, a new axis is observed with Iran influencing all Shiite countries, Qatar, which is an arm of Hezbollah and part of the Lebanese government, is also afraid of Iran and ends up participating in the group. Syria, which does not have a Shiite majority, opened the door to Iran when it defeated ISIS in Syria to create military bases for Iranian forces facing Israel's border.

Finally, we have Huths who are part of the Yemeni government, also an arm of Iran, installed on the border of Saudi Arabia created to be resistance against Saudi Arabia.

Iran wants ethnic cleansing, they use the Arabs to get their hands dirty, as the Nazis used and recruited, for example, the Slavs to do the work, and they did so, as the hatred against the Jews was greater than the resistance itself.

Richard J. Evans, a historian at the University of Cambridge, explains that the Nazi plan was unlike any other ethnic genocide:

"The genocide of five to six million Jews committed by Nazi Germany and its allies during World War II is, in some respects, in a different category from the ethnic genocides that have occurred throughout history.

Unlike the objects of other genocides, Jews were regarded by their Nazi killers as the 'world enemy', to be actively sought out wherever they lived and killed without exception, in a comprehensive process of extermination that was to continue until there were no Jews left. nowhere in the world.

The Nazis treated Jews with a sadistic ferocity rarely expressed in the other victims of their violence: Jewish men encountered on the Eastern Front by German forces were deliberately humiliated, their beards set on fire, or forced to perform gymnastic exercises until they fell to the ground from exhaustion. Jewish girls were forced to clean bathrooms with their blouses on." (BP)



In Richard's text, the actions of the Nazi Germans are observed, their barbaric behavior is almost identical to that of the terrorist group Hamas. It is not known what psychopathy forms this barbarity, what can be concluded is that these murderers are not part of the human persona. However, it is clear that some Nazi leaders, especially Hitler and Himmler, were quite Islamophiles and repeatedly expressed their sympathy for Islam. time Hitler criticized Every Catholic Church during the war years, he countered Islam as a positive example.

While condemning Catholicism as a weak, weak, effeminate religion, he praised Islam as a religion of warriors, strong and aggressive. This motive was repeatedly taken up by other Nazi leaders. Overall, however, what lay behind German policy regarding Islam were strategic considerations, not ideological conceptions. (DW)





HITLER IN 2023

On November 12, Israeli forces found the famous book, "My Struggle", the autobiography of Adolf Hitler, from a Hamas terrorist base in Gaza. The Arabic translation of the dictator's autobiography was discovered in a child's room that served as a Hamas terrorist base.

He wrote notes, highlighted passages, and studied again and again Hitler's ideology of hating Jews, of killing Jews, of burning Jews, of massacring Jews," Herzog said, concluding that terrorists "basically support this ideology".

The reason for Israel's security

The first time I heard about Mossad was in 1973, at the age of 8, when I immigrated with my family to Israel. At this time, a few years after the attacks on the Israeli Team at the Munich Olympics, I remember hearing my father say that our trip had been accompanied by Mossad agents. The second time I came into contact with some information about the Mossad was when I was a teenager, back in 1982, back in Israel, in the "The Brazilian Class" Program: a year of Studies and Work at an Agricultural School called Ayanot. I have been an avid reader since childhood and with my mother as an example, it was through the book "The Spy from Damascus" by Zwi Aldouby and Jarrold Ballinger, that my genesis. Among countless political facts, the book tells the story of Eli Cohen, an Israeli spy who infiltrated the highest circles in the Arab world, sending coded information, photos, etc... that would help Israel win, after his death, the War of Six Days. Eli Cohen, in what would be his last mission, ended up being discovered, tried, convicted, and hanged in a public square, in Syria. I recommend reading!

The first danger I experienced as a Jew, without knowing that I was already an Israeli citizen, was in 1983 at Schiphol Airport, in Amsterdam, when I traveled with a t-shirt written in Hebrew and a Barista, refused to serve me with: -"No I serve Jews." At the time, the usefulness of an intelligence service that aimed at attacking Jews already seemed justified to me.

As you can see, life in "Judea" or in the Diaspora, has never been easy for the Jews, going through all kinds of carnage: such as pogroms, Nazism, etc.... and if a State needs intelligence as additional security, with Israel it would be no different, having Jewish citizens, inside and outside its borders and yes, Israel is a Jewish State.





INTELLIGENCE AND SPECIAL TASKS SERVICE"

The Intelligence and Special Tasks service", which must avoid actions that are minimally dangerous for Jews, a fact that apparently happens from time to time.

Created in 1949 by David Ben-Gurion, the Prime Minister, shortly after the creation of the state of Israel. Ben Gurion wanted a central body to coordinate and improve cooperation between the existing security services – the Army Intelligence Department (AMN), the Internal Security Service (Shin Bet), and the "political department" of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. It has three distinct structures:

MILITARY INTELLIGENCE SERVICE (LATER AMN- AGAF HAMODI'IN, WHICH IS AN INDEPENDENT FORCE AND NOT PART OF THE ISRAELI ARMED FORCES):

One of AMAN's main units, Sayeret Matkal, is also tasked with a wide variety of often clandestine special operations, such as combat search and rescue, counterterrorism, hostage rescue, humint (a category of intelligence derived from information gathered and provided by sources human rights), irregular warfare, long-range penetration, conducting manhunts, special operations and special reconnaissance beyond Israel's borders.

INTERNAL SECURITY SERVICE (LATER SHIN BET):

Israel Security Agency (שֵׁירוֹת הַבִּיטָּחוֹן הַכְּלָלִי), Sherut haBitahon haKlali) better known by the acronym Shabak (שב"כ) or Shin Bet (a two-letter abbreviation) or even, Sha bak is responsible for safeguarding state security, exposing rings terrorists, interrogate suspected terrorists, provide information for counterterrorism operations in the West Bank and Gaza Strip,

counterintelligence, personal protection of senior public officials, protecting important infrastructure and government buildings, and safeguarding Israeli airlines and embassies abroad. Although it is a security agency, it is not part of the Israeli Ministry of Defense and its head reports directly to the Prime Minister.

INTELLIGENCE SERVICE OPERATING ABROAD (LATER MOSSAD):

The Mossad is responsible for intelligence gathering, covert operations, and combating terrorism. Its director reports directly and only to the Prime Minister.

TZOMET:

The largest division of the Mossad made up of case officers called katsas, was tasked with conducting espionage abroad and commanding agents. Officials at Tzomet operate under a variety of covers, including diplomatic and unofficial.

CAESAREA:

It conducts special operations and houses the Kidon unit (Hebrew: מְיֹדוֹן, "bayonet", "javelin" or "spear"), an elite group of assassins.

KESHET ("RAINBOW"):

Electronic surveillance, break-ins, and wiretapping
Human Resources.

METADATA:

A special unit that supposedly runs "small units of fighters" whose missions include "preventive sabotage."

Understanding that the Mossad and the Shin Bet are equivalent to the Israeli CIA and FBI, I do not believe there is any doubt as to the need for the existence of armed forces in the constitution of any sovereign country, especially with the recurring threats of destruction to the State of Israel.

ISRAEL DEFENSE FORCES (IDF):

(FDI; Hebrew: צְבָא הַהְגָנָה לְיִשְׂרָאֵל Tsva ha-Hagana le-Yisra'el, 'The Defense Army of Israel'), in Hebrew Tzahal (צה"ל), is the national army of the State of Israel. It consists of three branches of service: the Israeli Land Forces, the Israeli Air Force, and the Israeli Navy. It is the only military wing of the Israeli security apparatus. The IDF is headed by the Chief of the General Staff, who is subordinate to the Israeli Minister of Defense.

By order of David Ben-Gurion, the IDF was formed on 26 May 1948 and began operating as military personnel recruited from the already existing paramilitaries, namely Haganah, the Irgun, and Lehi. It was formed shortly after Israel's Declaration of Independence and has participated in all armed conflicts involving Israel.

*The IDF (in English) was created before the Intelligence and Special Tasks Services.

What I didn't know and only discovered in 2014, is that every immigrant, on their first Alliah (immigration) to Israel, receives a Tehudát Zehut, equivalent to our ID, regardless of their age. In 1983, when I left Israel back to Brazil, at the age of 18, at the age of military service, I was not aware of my citizenship and was surprised by the Immigration official who asked for my Israeli passport. I had to explain why I didn't: I returned to Brazil at the age of nine, being dependent on my parents, I had no choice, and with the adults' decision, I followed them. I think immigration could have even prevented me from traveling to serve in the IDF, which I would have been very proud to do.

Unfortunately, they didn't!



Palestinian Islamic Jihad (PIJ) was founded in 1981 by Fathi Abd al-Aziz al-Shikaki, a doctor from Rafah in the Gaza Strip. Although it emerged through the Muslim Brotherhood network in Palestine, it soon developed into a distinct organization, shaped by rising militarism and heavily influenced by the Iranian Revolution of 1979. Iran remains an important source of funding to this day. It is believed to have good working relations with Egyptian intelligence, although it has grown closer to Iran under al-Nakhalah.

Islamic Jihad acts as an elite vanguard rather than a broad community movement and opposes political engagement with Israel. It has a long history of attacks on Israeli soldiers and civilians, dating back to the 1980s. Its armed wing, the al-Quds Brigades, was founded in 1992.



ISLAMIC JIHAD

Although Islamic Jihad is sharply critical of the Palestinian Authority policies, it does its participate in politics and limits its role to military confrontation with However, i t Israel. has participated student i n running candidates in Palestinian university elections since the 1980s.

It also participated in the 1996 legislative elections. The group participated in intra-Palestinian reconciliation efforts between Hamas and Fatah.

The organization maintains a secret and ostensibly disciplined cellular structure. Its first members were Islamic activists and students from the Islamic University of Gaza. But it members also attracted o f the secular Fatah and the Marxist Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine (PFLP).

MAPPING PALESTINE POLITICS

In August 2022, Israel fought a battle against Islamic Jihad, which began on Friday, with the death of another commander of the radical Islamic organization.

The current spike in tension began after the arrest, on Monday, of the senior leader of the Islamic Jihad organization in the West Bank, Bassem Saadi.

Faced with rumors about the possibility of retaliatory armed actions from the Palestinian enclave, Israel launched a preemptive attack against Jihad targets in Gaza.

According to DW, Islamic Jihad militants continued firing rockets at Israel throughout Saturday night, while the Israeli military maintained airstrikes in Gaza.

On Friday and Saturday, Islamic Jihad fired hundreds of rockets into Israeli territory which, according to the Israeli military, were mostly intercepted by the Iron Dome defense system or reached inhospitable locations.







Fatah is the Arabic acronym for the National Liberation Movement, a secular nationalist organization created by Yasser Arafat and other activists in the late 1950s. The party is currently led by Mahmoud Abbas.

The main bodies within Fatah are the Central Committee (the executive branch) and the Revolutionary Council (the legislative branch), both elected by a General Congress. Fatah has held seven conferences throughout its history.

Fatah has experienced internal conflict throughout its history in exile and at home. It effectively took control of the Palestinian Authority (PA) in 1996 and is widely seen by Palestinians as corrupt. The party lost much of its dominant position following the death of Arafat and the loss of the 2006 parliamentary elections to Hamas.

After the 2007 infighting, Fatah was weakened in Gaza and was broken up as a national movement. The party was further divided by internal rivalries between Abbas and Mohammed Dahlan, who now operates through a new organization called the Fatah Democratic Reform Movement.

The seventh and most recent General Conference was held in 2016 in Ramallah and was seen as a move by Mahmoud Abbas to strengthen his control over the party by expelling his rival Dahlan and marginalizing popular Fatah figure Marwan Barghouti.

Throughout its history, Fatah has organized and carried out numerous attacks against Israeli military and civilian targets. In 1988, it was removed from the United States list of terrorist organizations after renouncing terrorism

Yemen's Houthi group claimed responsibility for a drone and missile attack against Israel, signaling the group's entry into the Israel-Hamas war. They declared support for the extremist group.

The Houthis are a Shiite military and political organization that controls part of Yemen after taking the capital Sanaa in 2014, which led to war in the country. Today, the officially recognized government, which is supported by Saudi Arabia, is based in Aden.

They are part of the Iran-aligned regional alliance hostile to Israel and the United States, which includes Lebanon's Hezbollah and Iranian-backed militias in Iraq.

The group's military spokesman, Yahya Saree, stated the possibility of more attacks "to help the Palestinians achieve victory." Saree blames Israel for the region's instability.

The Houthis' slogan is "Death to America, Death to Israel, curse the Jews and victory to Islam."

HOUTHIS



The attack on the 31st would have been the third organized by the group: the first took place on October 19th — the United States Navy intercepted three cruise missiles — and another on October 28th, which resulted in explosions in Egypt.

On November 6, the Houthis, from Yemen, carried out drone attacks that targeted "various" and "sensitive" points in Israel, which led to the paralysis of movement in Israeli bases and airports. The announcement of the attack was made on Al Masirah TV, a TV channel belonging to the Yemeni group itself.

Through a statement shown on TV, the movement's military spokesman, Yahya Saree, reported that a "large number" of missiles were fired towards Israeli territory and that more attacks like this are planned. According to him, the actions against Israel are aimed at "helping the Palestinians to victory".



DONA JUPIRA AND THE WAR IN ISRAEL

Mainstream media and social networks report that Dona Jupira is a Minas Gerais native, from Betim, aged 57, married for over 30 years, and with three children and 4 grandchildren. Furthermore, she is a caregiver for a boy with an irreversible mental disorder and an evangelical attendee of the Baptist Church.

Even without attributes that place her in the beer, rump steak, and jackfruit group - Dona Jupira received a sentence of 14 years in prison, being on provisional release, with the use of an electronic ankle bracelet, at the moment, until the final hammer is hit about his sentence, by the gods of Mount Olympus, for the alleged attempted coup d'état and abolition of the "Democratic" State of Law, the so-called Anti-Democratic Acts of January 8th.


Sentenced to 14 years by Alexandre de Moraes, the housewife hopes for a new trial. (7. Oct.23)

Professor, in the War against ideological indoctrination, whatever it may be.



I've always been a happy and curious child, one of those who can't be alone and who even talks to dogs. Born practically within a club, Clube Atlético Indiano, in the south of São Paulo, a club frequented by Roberto Rivelino, childhood Sérgio, etc... my memories are filled with wonderful sporting moments. Maybe and not just for that reason, at the age of 11 I decided what my career would be, after training with the kindest Artistic Gymnastics Teacher (Olympic at the time) I had ever met, Gildo.

Professor Gildo was a member of the Military Police Ball Corps and was an example of a Human Being and a Teacher that I bring to myself. Yes, I would be a Physical Education Teacher.

Faculty of Physical Education and two postgraduate degrees later, one in Children's Physical Education and the other in Movement Pedagogy, I had already worked in two large schools in São Paulo, one with Sports Aerobics, for twenty years and the other with Artistic Gymnastics, for nine years. Around 12 Brazilian Aerobics Gymnastics Championships and a Vice World Youth Championship in Miami in 2002. I taught almost my entire life in Brazil. During that time I never used my classes to talk about Politics, Religion, or any subject that was outside my area of interest. This was not my witnessed responsibility, but indoctrinating teachers.

Then, in December 2014, I moved with my husband to Israel and in September 2016, after a sabbatical year, I started teaching Childhood Education in Israel, Israeli education in Childhood Early Education is naive, vibrant, and full of stimuli to discover the world of writing and mathematics, with a solid background in History, Family, and Religion. Israeli children are an outlier. These are children who are not accustomed to Touch and in Physical Education this is a constant in classes.

The Israeli is called Sabra (cactus fruit) because it is full of thorns on the outside, but when you remove them, the fruit is sweet. Distrustful, very suspicious, until they get to know you well. Being Brazilian, I would arrive at Ganim "pre-schools" and kiss, yes, I would kiss them and what would they do? They cleaned and I said, you can complain... Time passed and there they were, around me, playing with my hair, hugging me, kissing me, and sitting on my lap, one on each leg.





Doing a little Google research on education and communism, the content is stomach-churning and so I was horrified when I came across this on the MEC website:

"As defined in the National Education Guidelines and Bases Law (LDB, Law No. 9,394/1996), the Base must guide the curricula of the teaching systems and networks of the Federative Units, as well as the pedagogical proposals of all public and private schools of Early Childhood Education, Elementary Education, and Secondary Education, throughout Brazil.

The Base establishes knowledge, skills, and abilities that all students are expected to develop throughout basic schooling. Guided by the ethical, political, and aesthetic principles outlined by the National Curriculum Guidelines for Basic Education, the Base adds to the purposes that direct Brazilian education towards the integral human formation and the construction of a fair, democratic, and inclusive society"

It is so difficult for an Educator, who is not used to using his students as a tool for maneuvering, to understand what we are experiencing. I worked with Palestinian students and never made a distinction between them. Why do these adults, terrorists, have so much hatred for the Jewish People? Where does this indoctrination come from? What is the "Education" that makes children have such visceral hatred at such a tender age and mature with such deadly hatred, capable of committing such barbaric acts?

I worked in many of the locations that were attacked by Hamas, including Netiv Hassará, Kibbutzim Zikim, Carmia, and the city of Sderot. I keep thinking to myself here: How can an adult do such heinous harm to a child?

Is Palestinian "Education" indoctrinating? Could this indoctrination be the cause of this hatred from such a young age?



Much has been said about judicial activism and/or the dictatorship implemented by the Judiciary in Brazil, accusations with abundant evidence given the increasing departure from their powers established in the Federal Constitution.

In any case, given that this is a clear invasion of competence, the resulting commands, and abuses, as well as the undeniable need for Congress to take place, it is necessary to analyze the issue more broadly and less emotionally.

In this sense, it is necessary to remember that this usurpation of powers has been implemented in a crescendo, which began timidly, way back, when the Federal Supreme Court itself began to decide on controversial topics, such as the concept of family and same-sex union and, to Starting in 2019, through the political and social intensification that led to the "disharmonization" of the constituted powers, the judicial vehicle started to move down a slope, without brakes and a steering wheel, all with the connivance of the National Congress itself, which injected it with a lot of fuel and no brakes.

Thus, there is no point in appealing to victims or dementia, as the Brazilian law house is frankly guilty, even as a participant, for the usurpation that occurred. Partly due to ineffectiveness, partly because she did not want to face issues that could wear her down in the eyes of the electorate, partly because she agreed with the rigging carried out by the Executive Branch in the Judiciary, and partly due to interests other than national and collective ones, which made her silent. supporting such conduct, with Minister Fux's statement, at an event for businesspeople, about Congress's omission of its obligations worth mentioning:

"It is not possible for the courts to be forced to decide everything because they are displeased by public opinion at alarming levels. And it's not our problem."

Taking advantage of the hook of his words, it is understood that this legislative negligence was premeditated, having as its overflow line the decision that removed and/or relativized the shields granted in article 53, of the Federal Constitution, for the then Deputy Daniel Silveira, creating a fantastic precedent for the removal of political opponents, which is even dangerous for the implemented democratic system itself.

And notice, since then, the countless times that parliamentarians from the so-called "right", another fallacy to be discussed and unmasked in the country, have suffered fierce political and personal persecution that would lead them to lose their positions or be neutralized, in a kind of field of political readjustment, all this in parallel to several statements issued by the same Judiciary, in collusion with Congress itself, in the sense of changing the political system.

This thesis gains weight not only when investigating the articles published on the subject, but also when analyzing the obvious performance of the most congressmen, such as Arthur Lira and Rodrigo Pacheco, who had poor and/or conniving performances in the face of the overt and aggressive actions of the Judiciary, and of the "vibrant" during the administration, as is the case of Deputy Carla Zambelli and Nikolas Ferreira himself, exponents in the votes in their States, who, visibly, were softened with forceps in their speeches after having their accounts in social networks blocked by the Federal Supreme Court.

Therefore, when all these measures are taken and others, such as Rodrigo Pacheco proposing to temporarily limit the position of Ministers, it must be borne in mind that there are no innocent people in this brothel, but there is a group of parliamentarians who are unhappy because they are losing the power already acquired. , others because they are not able to enjoy the benefits of the desired power, and others because the great Theater of Scissors that is Brazilian politics came to the surface.




soldiers who The participated in the movement were led by Marshal Deodoro da Fonseca, who was commander of the Brazilian Army. The civilians who participated in the movement were led by the jurist Benjamin Constant, who was one of the republic's main ideologues.


The movement began on November 15. 1889. when the military took power from the imperial government. Emperor Dom Pedro II was deposed and Brazil became a republic.

The Proclamation of the Republic was an important event in the history of Brazil. It marked the end of the monarchy and the beginning of the republic in the country.

NOVEMBER 19TH - WHAT DO THE COLORS OF THE FLAG MEAN?

The new republican government, led by Marshal Deodoro da Fonseca, needed symbols that represented the new political order. One of the most important symbols of the Brazilian Republic was the flag.

The flag of the Empire of Brazil, which had been adopted in 1822. was modified to represent the new republican values. The new flag was Raimundo designed bν Teixeira Mendes, one of the leaders of the republican movement.

The flag has a green rectangle, with a horizontal yellow stripe at the top, and a blue diamond in the center. In the diamond, there is a constellation of stars, representing the Brazilian states.

The colors of the Brazilian flag were inspired by the colors of the royal houses of Dom Pedro I's family. Green represented the royal house of Bragança, to which Dom Pedro I belonged, while yellow represented the royal house of Habsburg, to which the Empress belonged. D. Maria Leopoldina - wife of Dom Pedro



WHAT DO THE ELEMENTS OF THE IMPERIAL FLAG MEAN?



See what each of the elements means:

- green rectangle: symbolizes the house of Braganças, it is the Portuguese family into which Dom Pedro I was born.
- yellow diamond: symbolizes the house of Habsburg, it is the Austrian family into which Dona Leopoldina was born. According to symbology expert João Menna, the diamond represents women, remembering those who worked during Brazil's Independence.
- plant branches below the coat of arms: these are branches of two plants, coffee, and tobacco. These were very important for the Brazilian economy.

- crown: represents the imperial crown used by Brazilian monarchs.
- circle in the middle of the flag: this is the armillary sphere, an important navigation instrument, showing the influence of the Portuguese past in Brazil.
- the cross: represents the order of Christ and the Catholic church in general. The Brazilian Empire had Catholicism as its official religion.
- stars: the stars represent the provinces of the Brazilian Empire. The provinces were equivalent to current states.
- Dom Pedro I was the person responsible for having Brazil's first flag made.

MEANING AFTER THE PROCLAMATION OF THE REPUBLIC:

With the proclamation of the Republic in 1889, the colors of the flag were given new meaning. Green came to represent the country's forests, its natural wealth, and its biodiversity. Yellow came to represent the country's mineral wealth, such as gold and diamonds.

Blue and white were also given new meanings. Blue came to represent the sky and the ocean, which surround Brazil. White came to represent peace and harmony.



THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PROCLAMATION AND FLAG DAY

Flag Day is a commemorative date that celebrates the adoption of the Brazilian flag as a national symbol. The date was chosen because it was the day after the Proclamation of the Republic, which was the event that gave rise to the current flag.

The Proclamation was an important event in the history of Brazil, as it marked the end of the monarchy and the implementation of the republican regime. The new flag, which was adopted after the Proclamation, represents the new republican values and Brazilian national identity.




OTHER MEANINGS:

Apeirokalia and Hamas' Islamic brutality



It was in a fun conversation with Andre Assi Barreto that he reminded me of this term that is so important for understanding our times. I recommend you watch it on my channel and follow it on social networks, it's a sure win.

A-pair-kalia (denial, experience, beauty) means a disease of the soul caused by the lack of contact with beauty. Without the inspiration of Beauty in human formation, the result is a person without the ability to even detect Beauty. This can, in practice, only result in bad taste. But it is also one of the ingredients for the brutalization of the soul, an indispensable prerequisite for a life of barbarism.

It is no surprise that apeirokalia is lovingly cultivated by regressism, in all spheres. You will see a regressive applauding the most hideous funk and turning up his nose at the favela resident playing the violin. You will also see this group incense graffiti artists who produce urban dirt or applaud installers in modern disaster museums. It is necessary to lose the notion of Beauty to facilitate the process of moral and logical degradation.

With Beauty in life, it is much more difficult to imagine a world where morals are relative, where Good or Truth does not exist. But what does this have to do with Islamic brutality?

Dennis Prager, speaking in Oxford, touches lightly on this subject. He exposes a terrifying fact: that the number of book translations into Arabic in ten years is similar to the number of translations into Greek in ONE year. This closure of the Arab world is undoubtedly caused by Islam and not by the Arab mentality itself, which has already produced much beauty in the distant past.



Prager also makes a statement that is self-evident but a fact never exposed by the mainstream Western media. There is only one type of aggressor who takes people's heads off, who burns and stones his victims and uses rape as a weapon of combat. He is the Islamic aggressor. This is an unquestionable fact.

Boko Haram, Hezbollah, ISIS, Al Qaeda, Hamas, Islamic Jihad, Egyptian Islamic Jihad, Muslim Brotherhood, Popular Front of India, Mujahedins of India, and many others, a list too long to fit here, are all Islamic. To disregard this religious and ideological alignment is to completely deny reality. Imagining that violence is the result of Israel's presence or is concentrated in the Middle East is another easily verifiable fallacy. I give as an example the case reported by the media of the transformer truck that ran over and killed more than 80 people in Nice, France, in 2016.

Surprisingly, the truck was being driven by a person, named Mohamed Lahouaiej-Bouhlel. Even the hesitant French government of the time (Hollande) named the attack Islamic terrorism. At the time, finding any reference to the religion professed by the monster driver Mohamed in the mainstream media was an impossible task. As is the current practice to this day.

Beauty is what brings us closer to God, and this effect is true even for those who do not believe. This was one of the reasons that motivated the envious Marcel Duchamp to work for the destruction of art, an objective he confessed in an interview with Joan Bakewell in 1968. This was what exposed a urinal as a work of art. Such a grotesque line of antiartistic thought predominates in the current postmodern world, a world that succumbed to the vertical invasion of barbarians, as denounced by Mário Ferreira dos Santos in a book of the same name.

This existential rise through aesthetics is not limited to the visual but includes all types of art, with an emphasis on music, the most visceral and primitive artistic genre. With music, God-worshipping geniuses like Mozart and Johann Sebastian Bach created great works of art that are true stairs to divine Light. Mozart loved the Lord so much that he included Amadeus in his surname, contrary to what Milos Forman's cinematic pamphlet suggested. The great composer Bach signed his works with the insignia SDG, which means Soli Deo Gloria, or only for the glory of God.

Terror then aims, in a sense, to bring the world to its own doom in much the same way that Muslims work violently and incessantly to bring the world to their political-religious system. The brute hates the Beautiful and destroys it whenever he can. In the opposition to the Beautiful there is also the opposition to the Truth and the facts clearly show the very strong similarity of this brutalization of the Islamic world with the regressism that we see in the indoctrinated youth of the West.

The destruction of historical monuments carried out by ISIS in the Middle East finds a cruel echo in the removal of statues by ignorant Westerners.

Therefore, there should not be much surprise in observing the defense of bloodthirsty Islamists like Hamas by so many Westerners. Barbarism has already invaded the West for many decades, brought by many agents, some today professors in moral cesspools such as the former prestigious Harvard University.

The defense of Beauty, then, is one of the great needs of the West. If we want to overcome the horror of Islamic terrorist barbarism we have to fight the agents of destruction of Beauty on our street corners. Without Beauty, there can be no free world.





There are many sacred books and many religious and pagan beliefs spread throughout the world and its civilizations, among them the TORAH and the QURAN stand out, as they are followed and observed by the two largest known beliefs, Torah Judaism and the Quran Islam.

- The Torah (SACRED BOOK OF JUDAISM) is one of the oldest writings and records ever known, approximately 3300 BC, being adopted as a rule of faith and practice of the Jews, for containing in its compendium the writings of Moses, five first books of the Torah, which together form a single one, the PENTATEUCH (in Hebrew Chumash, Chamishá, Chumshê), these being:

- GENESIS, Bereshit in the beginning
- EXODUS, Shemot the names of the people in Israel and Egypt
- NUMBERS, Bamidbar the journey of the Israelites to the land of milk and honey, Canaan
- DEUTERONOMY, Devarim- God's instructions
- LEVITICUS, Vayicrá the history of the Jewish people

They were written by Moses during the pilgrimage in the desert when the Hebrews left Egyptian slavery in Egypt and returned to their lands in Canaan, a place today called Israel, where their entire history began. It is worth remembering that the sacred compendium for the Jews includes books other than the Pentateuch, books of historical records, prophecies, songs, and various teachings.

Later, the Torah was also adopted by so-called Christians (after the ascension of the story of Jesus Christ), as part of the sacred book, added to many other books, discovered and translated, that bring in their content the history of divinity and salvation.

At this junction, we have the well-known OLD TESTAMENT – BC, and NEW TESTAMENT AD or the Holy Canon, or Holy Bible as it is commonly known today.

- The Qur'an (HOLY BOOK OF ISLAM), in turn, is the book of guidance, faith, and practice of Muslims and Islamists, dating from approximately 600 AD, and is about the teachings of God (Allah) to the prophet Muhammad through the angel Jibril.



Many of his quotes are similar to the already known Torah and Christian Bible, diverging with the names of characters mentioned in both, recreating a new identity to the existing story.

One of the main differences between them we can highlight: The Torah highlights God and Moses, the Holy Bible highlights God, Moses, and Jesus Christ and the Quran highlights Allah, Muhammad, and Muhammad

Other comparisons worth highlighting:




QURAN:

Language: It was written in classical Arabic and later translated into 47 languages around the world.

Number of verses: 6346 Chapters: 114 (86, are about the life of Prophet Muhammad in Makkah, and the other 28 are about the Prophet's migration to Medina).

Summary: The Quran is believed to be the final revelation of God (Allah) to humanity through the messages of Muhammad. The learning method is to recite the Quran every day to form a group of Muslims following the guidance of the Angel Gabriel and implies God's duties and responsibilities towards the world.

Published: The Quran was released in the 18th century, in the year 10, after the death of Muhammad in 632, when the prophet delivered the recitation in Ghadir Khumm. Revision: The translation of the Quran for scholars was difficult to decode the meaning, the revision began in the month of Ramadan. Written in the month of Ramzan by Prophet Muhammad according to the instructions of God, Allah, currently the Quran has been translated into more than 100 languages across the world.



We can also highlight converging points and divergent, between Muslims/Islamic and Judaism/Christianity:

For Muslims and Islamists, the Quran is just the words of Allah, which were sent to the Prophet Muhammad through the Archangel Gabriel. For Jews and Christians, it is the revealed word of God, in the Torah, and also the records and confirmations of the prophets and scribes, contained in the Bible.

Through the Qur'an, Islamists and Muslims believe they are correcting the interpretations of the Torah and the Bible, retelling the story through the adaptation of new characters, sometimes using the same story with different names and an affirmative approach, to emphasize that these are the true guidelines., from 600 BC.

It should be noted that both the Torah and the Christian Bible do not alter the understanding of the PENTATEUCH in any way, there are no differences in interpretation or in the approach itself. The same characters, the same orientations, and the same beliefs remain. Dating back to more than 3000, its content has not yet undergone any changes, just translations and idiomatic adaptations.

Issac, son of Abraham and Sarah (wife), as the fulfillment of the promise that the angel made to them. This legitimate son began Abraham's legacy and the promise that he and his descendants would be a nation chosen and differentiated from the others, that later, from this lineage, the savior of humanity would be born.

(Genesis 21:1-3). Isaac was the son of promise. Isaac later begat Jacob, who had his name resignified to Israel, the father of the twelve tribes and, finally, through the nation of Israel, Jesus Christ, the Messiah, came into the world, fulfilling the covenant that God had made with Abraham.

In the Qur'an, this story is told hiding the part linked to Issac, making use only of the quote from Ishmael, as being the only son and heir of Abraham and his promises, regardless of whether Sarah was the lawful wife or Hagar the Egyptian slave, another reaffirms Sara's point sterility, believing in the miracle of restoring her ability to generate, for their interpretation, and according to their beliefs, a woman is just a womb for the generation of children, therefore, they lose their significance in the context, permeating only around Abraham and his son.



Therefore, we can check and compare their quotations in the Quran (Sura 19:54); (Sura 37:83-109) and even compare with (Genesis 22:1-19) and that is why Muslims preach that the promises of God's covenant were made to the descendants of Ishmael, and not to Isaac, and further, that their Prophet Muhammad was a descendant of Ishmael.

While Jesus Christ, (the prophet for the Jews) the Savior for Christianity, descends from Issac, and in the description of the Torah and the Bible, the story of the existence of another son, Ishmael, is not hidden.

To this day, Muslims try to claim these promises of the covenant, of the paternity of Abraham, that is, the land and its geographical region, supposed "Palestine" (a name created later by the Greeks, which refers to the region of Philistia, was also known as the land of the Philistines). Romans and Muslims, after invading and the Hebrews and expelling Israelites from their lands, began to call the place Palestine.

In both the Torah and the Bible the word Palestine is not mentioned, only the geographical position. Since the UN-sanctioned Israel's return in 1948, there has been unremitting hostility between Israel and its Arab neighbors, with major armed conflicts in 1948-49, 1956, 1967, 1973-74, and 1982. That Israel remains there today is a miracle in itself.

Taking into account the size and content of both books, we would spend hours or days, perhaps months, comparing them. We emphasize some points among many others.

The objective of this article is just to inform, which is already clear. There is no incitement whatsoever. There is information and cited sources that can be verified in the Torah, the Bible, and also the Quran.

PRAY FOR CHRISTIANS IN
THE MIDST OF THE CONFLICT
BETWEEN ISRAEL AND GAZA PORTAS ABERTAS

As the war between Israel and Hamas continues to devastate the Gaza Strip, our Israeli and Palestinian brothers and sisters are calling for the world to pay attention to their situation. In particular, Christians in Palestinian Territories call for the world, including the global church, to remember them. The word says that we are united with the people of God in Israel, the Gaza Strip, and the West Bank, as "one body and one Spirit, just as the hope to which you were called is one" (Ephesians 4:4).

Portas Abertas partners in the region say Palestinian Christians feel trapped between their identity as Arabs and their Christian faith. They feel that the West treats them with suspicion because they are Palestinian, and some Palestinians distrust them for following lesus. Messianic Jews feel the same way: They say they are seen as traitors to Judaism and viewed with suspicion by their neighbors because they are Israeli.



Portas Abertas is not against nationality, government, or religion. We are pro-Jesus Christ. This means we seek to act in sacrificial humility for the goal of reconciliation-remaining faithful to our calling to "strengthen what remains and was about to die" (Revelation 3:2). That's why Open Doors has worked in the Holy Land for decades, helping our partners and local churches face pressure and persecution. Like other Christians around the world, we are shocked and terrified by Hamas' brutal attacks on Israel. We condemn this violence.

We are concerned about the ongoing war and its impacts on the civilian population. Civilians are being injured and killed by Hamas' extremist attacks and Israel's ongoing bombing campaign. We are mainly concerned about the 1,070 Christians in Gaza and the more than 45,000 Christians in the West Bank, Arab Christians, and Messianic Jews in Israel.

Open Doors founder Brother André did not simply believe in the need to stand alongside Israeli and Palestinian Christians, he demonstrated this by traveling to the region several times, creating deep relationships with Palestinian Christians in both Gaza and the West Bank, Messianic Jews, and Arab Christians in Israel.

Brother André shocked the world by meeting with leaders of Hamas and Islamic Jihad. He did so not to legitimize these groups, but because he believed they needed to know Jesus above all else. Whenever he could, Brother André took the opportunity to talk to them about the power of the gospel to change their lives.

Brother André's words in his book Force of Light (written with Al Janssen) seem prophetic for the current time. "The never-ending conflict left me distressed, but what hurt even more was knowing that my brothers and sisters were caught in the middle of the fighting. Portas Abertas' calls on the church around the world to listen to the voice and testimony of the Israeli and Palestinian Christian communities. We are deeply concerned about their vulnerability due to the marginalization they face because of which has their faith, now exacerbated by the current crisis. As the world takes sides in the conflict, it can be difficult to hear the voices of Christians in the region - but our faith tells us we need to do so because we are commanded to love our brothers and sisters. "He gave us this commandment: Whoever loves God must also love his brother" (1 John 4:21).

We fear that continued pressure on Palestinians threatens Christian witness in the Holy Land. "We are all shocked after seeing everything that is on TV and social media. I am in daily communication with our brothers and sisters who have taken shelter in the two churches in Gaza City. They are terrified and one of them told me: we smell death."

Pastor Evan Thomas, a Messianic Jew who serves in central Israel, says: "Everyone in Israel knows someone who knows a person or family whose members have been murdered, seriously injured, or kidnapped. We are a nation in shock and mourning and deeply concerned that our government and military failed to prevent this from happening." He adds: "We are in contact and unity with Arab Christian communities and regularly pray together; we exchange encouragement with each other in this mutual mourning."

Jack Sara, president of Bethlehem Bible College, in an interview with a Dutch Christian media outlet, said: "The feeling we have is that the Christian world has abandoned us. Very few are praying equally for Palestinians and Israelis. We have the feeling that Palestinian Christians are not important, we feel [as if we are seen as a] nuisance. Here, we think of a single church, we do not think of two peoples of God. But this is used against us, as being anti-Israel or even anti-Semitic. What we need from Christians around the world is a message of encouragement. We are very discouraged by this whole situation. We are here and we will continue because we believe that God calls us to our people, the Palestinians. I say: Love Israel and your neighbors, including the Palestinians."

This stance of unity directs our actions. And it should lead us first to get down on our knees in prayer.

One of Portas Abertas' core values is that "we are people of prayer". Therefore, we stand with Christians in the Middle East and call on Christians around the world to pray for peace in the region. A Christian (whose name is withheld for security reasons), who is part of a movement of Christians of Muslim origin in the region, shares:

We are watching our region burn and [has been] simmering for many years. In times of war, no one will be victorious. All sides will lose. This is what Jesus Christ told us: to pray for the peace and shalom of Jerusalem. Shalom, according to the Bible, is not just the absence of war or the absence of problems, but it means the security that God gives to our lives.

Our prayer is that God brings his peace to the region. Our hearts go out to the many Jewish families who have lost loved ones or are mourning their children, wives, and husbands [who were kidnapped] and those who are traumatized by these terrible attacks. But our hearts are also with the innocent people living in Gaza, men, women, and children who are not part of this war. We pray that the Lord will have mercy on them.

Let us come together to pray for peace in Jerusalem, peace in Israel, peace for the people in the West Bank, peace for the people in Gaza, and peace for the people in Lebanon, Syria, and Iraq, in the name of Jesus.

Open Doors echoes this Christian's call and prays against Satan's schemes that try to divide and foment violence in this conflict.

Join us and Christians in the Holy Land as we pray that the way of Jesus will be seen as the answer to this conflict. "On the cross Jesus won, not with weapons, not with political power, not by great means, not by imposing himself," wrote Christian leader Pizzaballa, from Jerusalem. "The peace that Jesus speaks of has nothing to do with victory over others. He overcame the world by loving it. A new reality and a new order indeed began at the cross. The order and reality of the one who gives his life for love. With the resurrection and the gift of the Spirit, this reality and this order belong to the disciples, to us. God's answer to the question of why the righteous suffer is not an explanation, but a presence - it is Christ on the cross. This is what we place our faith in today," he explains.

SEEK CHURCH UNITY

Open Doors echoes the call of Christians in the Middle East for unity – that we see one church rather than a divided body. In a recent sermon, a pastor in Egypt (which borders Gaza) made an impassioned plea for unity: "Our neighbors are in severe crisis. In the New Testament, we find that God loves all nations equally, Jews and Gentiles, slaves and masters, poor and rich; In Christ, there is no man or woman, Jew or Greek, he loves everyone equally. He loves those who believe in him, his children, and also those who do not believe in him. He loves them and died for them."

And on our borders, there is a war between two nations, between two religions. One of them has enormous support and the other is weak; the language used is the language of blood, bullets, bombs, and destruction. Blood is flowing in these lands and God sees it with great sadness. Every life that is taken on both sides hurts God's heart because he loves both sides equally", concludes the pastor.

Open Doors believes that the church is a body: "So in Christ, we, who are many, form one body, and each member is connected to all the others" (Romans 12:5). When one party suffers, all suffer with it (1 Corinthians 12:26). So when Open Doors' team of local partners struggles to serve Christians in the area, we are moved to hold them up in prayer, knowing that our prayers will strengthen and encourage them.

Brother André never shied away from speaking out against injustice, even in complicated situations. In the book Force of Light, he writes about his reaction to seeing suicide bombings in the Middle East: "Who was going up to the terrorists? Was anyone prepared to confront them and give them a reason to live that was greater than their motivation to die? How will they know about the Prince of Peace if no one goes and tells them?

This kind of radical faith is what we seek to emulate.

As Open Doors, we love followers of Jesus everywhere, and we love people for being made in the image of God, no matter their national, religious, or ethnic identity. Jesus died for his bride, which is a church, a body. We support and pray with and for followers of Christ - Arab and Palestinian Christians, Messianic Jews - because we believe strongly that God has his church there to expand the gospel through his people, to show Muslims and Jews the love and hope of Jesus, and to offer his love and forgiveness, his justice and reconciliation. We call on the church worldwide to awaken and join us as we listen, pray, and seek unity.

PSYCHOTRAUMA

Psychotrauma is an extremely disturbing psychological experience that can cause significant damage to mental health. It is a term used to describe the psychological response to a traumatic event, as defined in DSM III. In other words, psychic trauma is a normal response abnormal experience that can affect anyone, regardless of age, race, gender, or ethnicity.

The American Psychiatric Association APA, not highlighted the importance recognizing trauma and its effects on treatments but also encouraged new studies and understandings more focused on traumatic effects. It is estimated that 60% of people experience at least traumatic event in their lives, such accidents, violence, abuse natural disasters, and war.

It is estimated that 60% of people will experience at least one traumatic event in their lives, such as accidents, violence, abuse natural disasters, and war.

War is one of the traumatic events with the greatest impact on human beings, it can cause profound and irreparable psychological damage. These conflicts expose people to situations of death and destruction, loss and/or separation from loss of their ones, homes, deprivation, violence - murder, mutilation, rape, torture – and loss of sense of security. These experiences can generate a variety of psychic symptoms, such as depression, anxiety, flashbacks, nightmares, difficulty concentrating, relationship problems, social and isolation.



Once psycho trauma is established, it should not be neglected, it needs to be treated as soon as possible, and when this does not happen, the psychic trauma can evolve into PTSD (Post-Disorder). Traumatic Stress transition occurs when symptoms persist and increase after the traumatic event. The more serious and intense the event, the greater the likelihood of developing the disorder. The frequency of exposure is also important data to be analyzed as if the person continues to be exposed to situations similar to the trauma, the symptoms may worsen. Individual vulnerability - some people have a greater genetic predisposition the lack of support and the absence of adequate treatment can also prolong symptoms and consequently develop into PTSD.

Em conclusão, o psicotraumatismo e o TEPT são conceitos intrinsecamente ligados ao impacto do trauma na saúde mental. Enquanto 0 psicotraumatismo representa resposta inicial a eventos traumáticos, **TEPT** condição uma persistente e debilitante. Reconhecer essas diferenças é crucial para prevenir a evolução do quadro, evitando o trauma se agravar, bem como, fornecer intervenções adequadas.

A conscientização, o apoio social e o tratamento precoce desempenham um papel fundamental na mitigação dos efeitos do trauma. Portanto, é imperativo que profissionais de saúde mental e a sociedade em geral estejam atentos a essas questões, promovendo a resiliência e a recuperação daqueles que enfrentam experiências traumáticas.


